#### Note:

#### 1. Quit India Day:

A special assembly will be conducted in class. A PowerPoint presentation and a small video will be shown to enlighten the minds of our students and to give a glimpse into our past struggle for Freedom.

#### 2. Inter-House Elocution Competition:

The competition will be held post lunch.

**Grade 1 to 3:** Students will be required to speak for **1 minute** about their **'Favourite Freedom Fighter'**.

Grade 4 to 6: Students will be required to give a speech on the topic 'What Freedom means to Me', for 2 minutes.

Note: The students will be judged upon the following criteria: Introduction, Content, Intonation, Diction, Overall Presentation.

## 3. Inter-House 'Chakh Le India' (चख ले इंडिया) Competition:

The competition will be held post lunch.

**Grade 7 and 8**: Students will be required to prepare any dish and decorate it using the tri-colours – Saffron, White and Green. The student will present their dish and explain the ingredients and recipe in class during the competition.

Note: The students will be judged upon the following criteria: Introduction, Explanation, Visual Appeal of the dish, Creativity, Overall Presentation.

# 4. Inter-House Solo Patriotic Song Singing Competition (देश भिक्त गीत प्रतियोगिता): The competition will be held post lunch.

**Grade 9 and 10**: Students will be required to sing any **Hindi Patriotic Song** (One Stanza, One Chorus).

Note: The students will be judged upon the following criteria: Introduction, Rhythmic Accuracy, Memory, Posture/Presence and Confidence.

NOTE: For the above-mentioned Inter-House competitions, students are required to register their names with their respective class teachers before 06<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Students to perform in School Uniform or Smart Formals only.

### 5. Live Streaming of Independence Day Program:

**Grade 1-10:** Students will be required to join the Independence Day Celebration on Teams which will be live streamed through the link that will be provided.
