Recognizing the top ranked schools of the city

There is a reason why Pune has earned the sobriquet - 'City of the East'. With numerous outstanding schools vying for attention, the city is a veritable breeding ground for doctors, engineers and scientists. The pandemic, however, threatened to dull the sheen of Pune as an education hub. But the outstanding institutions here swiftly rose to the challenge by providing seamless learning via virtual classes. While this year has been unforgiving for everyone, some schools have clearly surpassed expectations. In an effort to appreciate these institutions, here are the finest schools in the city recognized as game-changers in the field.

A zone-wise survey was carried out by Dexter Consultancy Pvt. Ltd. to handpick the best schools. The aim of the survey was to rank the finest institutions in each zone in the city, and the result was tabulated through a 4-step approach, starting from desk research followed by a self-nomination step, parameter-wise analysis is the final ranking of the schools that participated in the survey. A sample survey was conducted across three zones in the city - East, West and PCMC. In arrive at the findings of Pune Times Mirror Top Schools-2021, a complete list of schools within the stipulated time was not included in the survey. Any entity that expressly stated unwillingness to participate in the survey was also excluded from the survey.

सीएम इंटरनॅशनल स्कूल हे पुणे शहरातील नावाजलेले स्कूल आहे. श्री खंडेराय प्रतिष्ठान शिक्षण संस्थेची स्थापना ही १९८९ मध्ये झाली. गणपतराव महातुनी बालवडकर यांनी या शिक्षण संस्थेची स्थापना केली. ही शाळा श्री खंडेराय प्रतिष्ठानच्या नेतृत्वाखाली चालते आहे. नवदश्या दशकात बालेखडी हा ग्रामीण भाग म्हणून ओळखला जायचा. बालेखडीमध्ये इयत्ता सातवीपर्यंत जिल्हा परिषदची शाळा होती. त्यामुळे परिसरातील मुलांना शिक्षण घेण्यास सोपे उपलब्ध नव्हती. प्रमुखाने मुलांना सातवीपासून पुढचे शिक्षण घेणे शक्य होत नसे. कारण सातवीनंतर पुढे शिकायचे म्हटले तर विद्यापीठ परिसरात शिकायला जावे लागे. त्यामुळे बरेचसे पालक मुलांना शाळेत पाठवायला तयार होत नसत. म्हणून गणपतराव बालवडकर यांनी शाळा काढायचे ठरवून त्यांनी आठवीपासून पुढचे वर्ग स्वतःच्या घरात सुरू केले. त्याची काळांतराने सीएम इंटरनॅशनल स्कूल अशी ओळख निर्माण झाली. या शाळेत आज प्री प्राथमरीपासून पदवीपर्यंत वेगवेगळे अभ्यासक्रम उपलब्ध आहेत.

विद्यार्थ्यांना विविध क्षेत्रात उल्लेखनीय कामगिरी बजावली आहे. शिवाय अनेक विद्यार्थी हे स्वतःच्या हिमरीने व्यवसायात अग्रेसरदेखील आहेत. या शाळेत बालेखडी, महाकुंगे, सुल, वाकड, अँध आदी परिसरातील मुले शिक्षणासाठी येत असतात.

➤ Smart Classes:

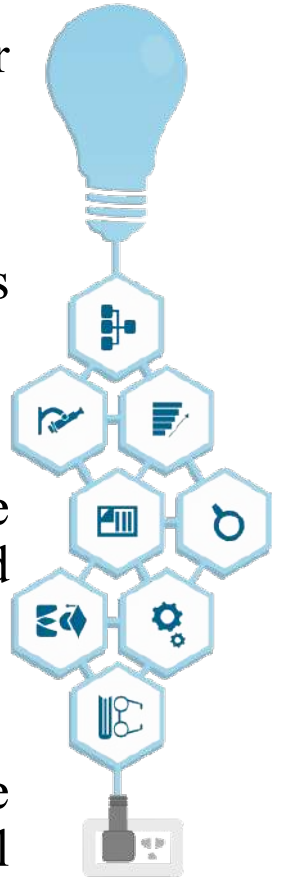
Our classrooms are un shackled learning spaces which have flexible seating arrangements and audio video facilities for effective learning.

Subject Enrichment Activity (SEA)

- One of the purposes of conducting oral exams was to provide a way of assessing students' comprehension rather than their written communication skills.
- Oral exams are being widely used to test students' verbal communication skills. Keeping this in mind we had planned the Oral Examination for our students, date sheet and timings were shared in groups along with detailed syllabus.
- SEA activities which included projects, experiments, charts related to topics for subjects were conducted for Grade 6 – Grade 9.
- We had divided the classes into two groups.
- Students were assessed thoroughly and graded accordingly.



Review of Examinations

- Exams are best way to assess students' understanding of a topic.
- Final Examinations have been successfully conducted in hybrid mode (Online & Offline) for Grade 1 - 10.
- Final Examination for each subject was a Pen- Paper Examination. It contained both Objective and Subjective Type Questions. Questions were in the form of MCQ, Fill in the Blanks, True or False, Very Short Type, Short Type and Long Type questions, Subject wise details were given by respective subject teachers.
- The results for the same will be announced during the Final Report Card Day.

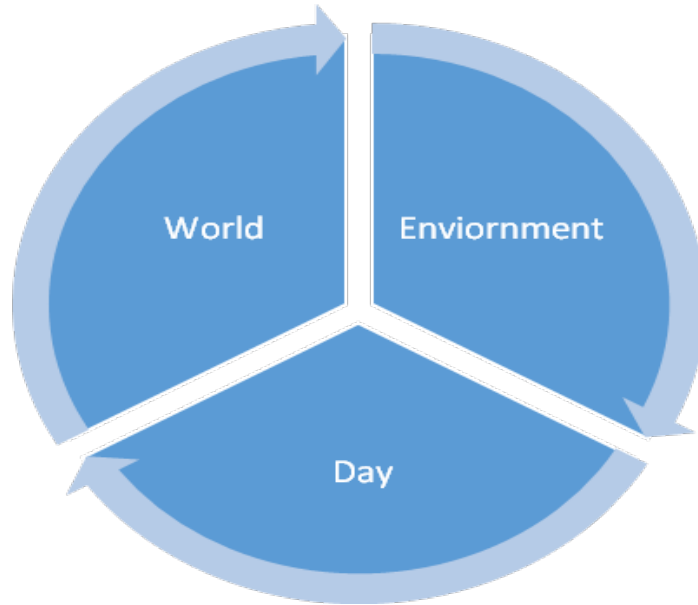
Investiture Ceremony

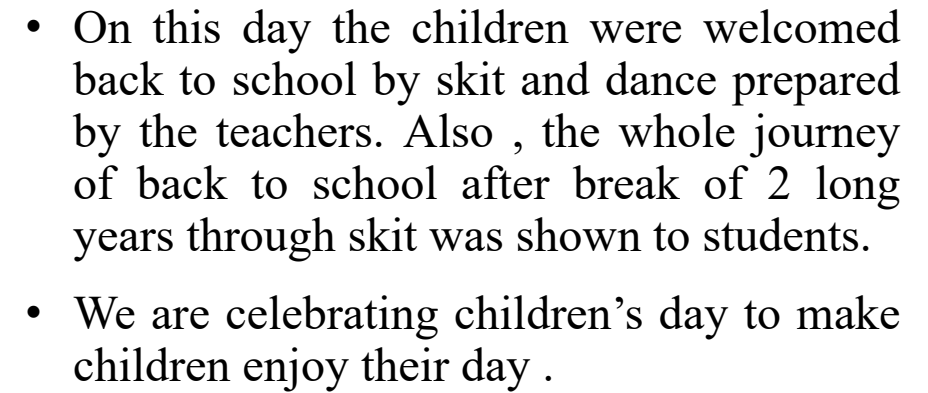


Special Assembly on Gurunanak Jayanti

The significance of Shiv Jayanti was explained to students through a PowerPoint presentation, which helped the students gain insight into Shivaji Maharaj. The celebration brought a sense of pride among the stu-

dents. Children were dressed in traditional attire and enjoyed the virtual tour titled - Shivkalin Pune.

Shivaji Bhosle, who is revered as Chhatrapati Shivaji, carved out an enclave from the declining Adil Shahi sultanate of Bijapur that led to the genesis of the vast Maratha Empire. In 1674, he was formally crowned at Raigad, as the Chhatrapati of a vast part of the sub-continent. Shivaji was born February 19, 1630 in the fort of Shivneri, which is now in Pune district. The Maharashtra gov-

ernment lists February 19 as a holiday commemorating Shivaji's birth as Shivaji Jayanti. Shivaji was named after a local deity, the goddess Shivaji. Shivaji was well known for his many forts. Like Panhala Fort and Rajgad existed before him, others, like Sindhudurg and Pratapgad, were built by him. The fort of Raigad was built as the capital of the Maratha Empire. These forts were central to his empire and their remains are among the foremost sources of information about his reign.

Torna Fort was the first fort captured by Shivaji Maharaj.

Sindhudurg was built to control attacks by the Portuguese and Siddhis on the coastal areas of the Maratha Empire. The hill fort of Salher in Nashik district was at a distance of 1,200 km (750 mi) from the hill fort Gingee, near Chennai. Over such long distances, hill forts were supported by sea forts, by serving as the first line of defence. These forts proved to be useful during the Mughal-Maratha wars.



Training for Teachers

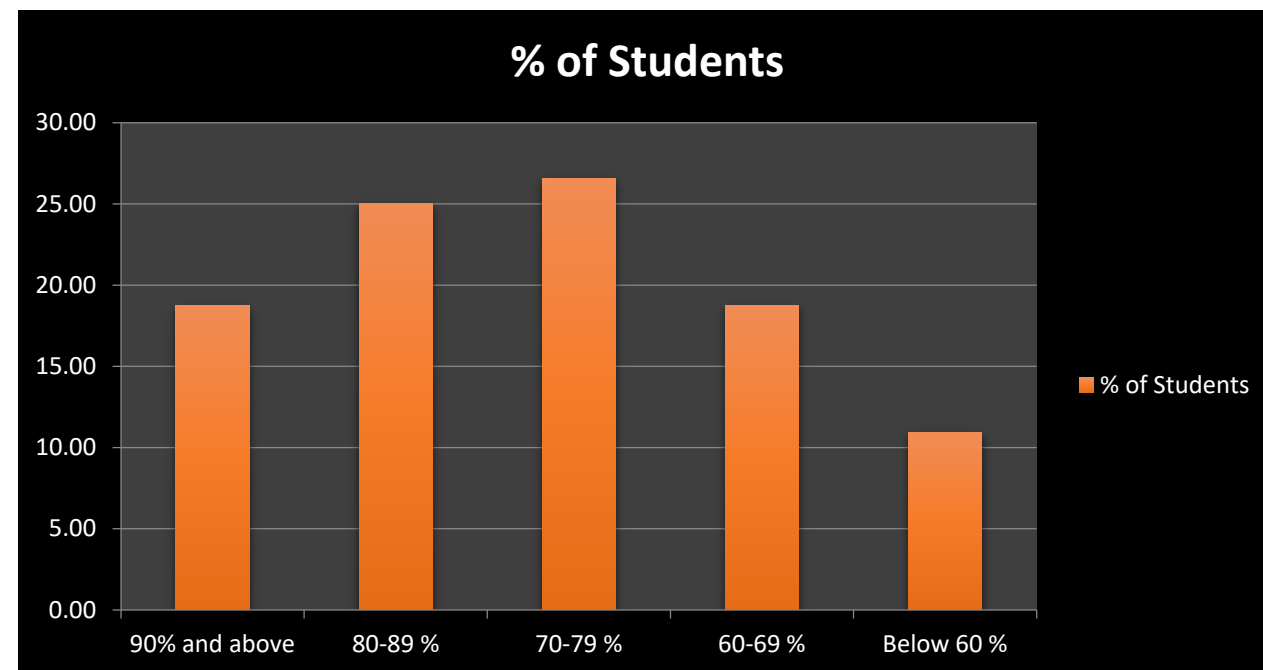
