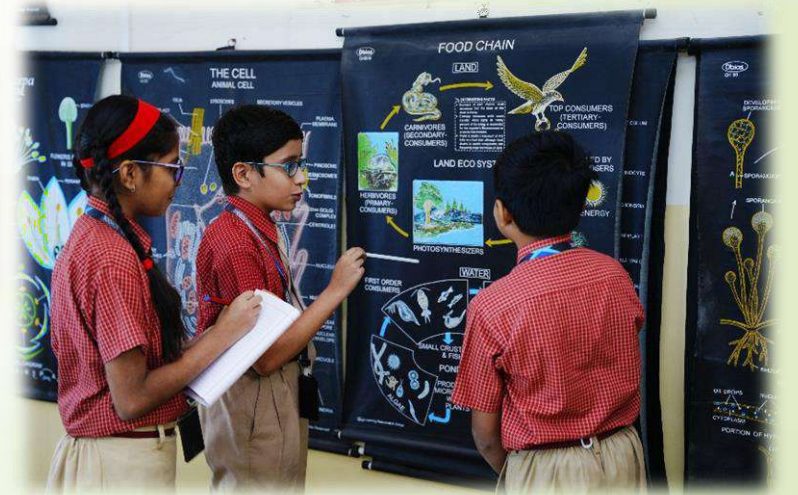

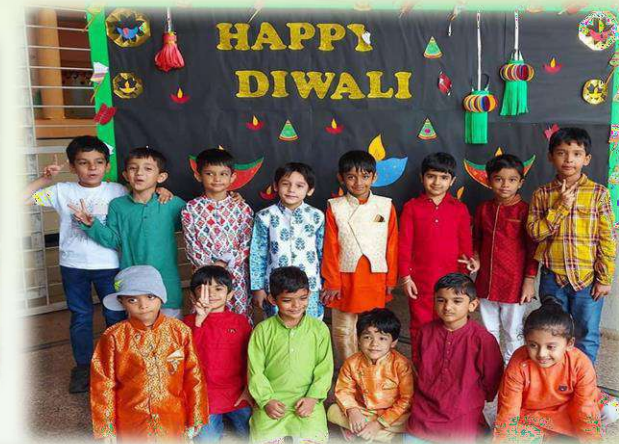

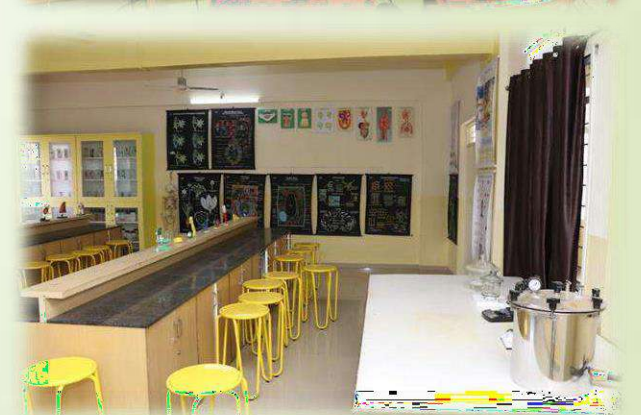

# Code of Conduct

## General Rules and Regulations:

- The regular school timings for Pre-Primary are from 8.50 a.m. to 1.30 p.m. and for Primary and Secondary are 8.50 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. Students must report to school before 8.50 a.m. Students reporting late will not be permitted for classes. Parents refrain from arguing with the security staff. Assembly will start sharp at 9.00 a.m.
- Kindly make sure the child comes in clean, neat and proper school and sports uniform according to days.
- Students to refrain from bringing sharp objects, toys, electronic gadgets, money to school. Smart Watches and expensive watches are not allowed. Students can wear basic regular watches.
- Students can wear coloured clothes on their birthdays. Distribution of chocolates, cakes, gifts of any sort are strictly not permitted. Parents can donate book to library on the occasion. Every student should take pride in keeping their class, surroundings and school campus clean.
- Attendance on the last day (before vacation) and first day (after vacation) is mandatory. Attendance during Independence Day and Republic Day is mandatory. No leaves will be granted on these occasions.
- Half days are strictly not permitted for any reason. If the child is unwell, keep the child at home to avoid spreading infection to other students. Let the child come to school only after he/she is absolutely well.
- Parents should sign the almanac daily and fill in he/she leave record in case of absenteeism.
- Parents should maintain a record of the circulars.
- Students are expected to speak in ENGLISH in the school premises. Though equal importance is given to other languages as well.
- Classwork, Homework, Projects and Worksheets are to be submitted within the stipulated time.
- The Management, Principal, Teachers, Office Staff, Support Staff all are to be treated with respect at all times by students and parents.
- Parents can pick and drop their child to school or avail bus facility provided by the transport vendor appointed by the school. No private transport will be allowed. Students will not be allowed to leave the school premises alone.
- Parents whenever visit the school should be in formal attire.

- Students are expected to come in proper and complete school uniform to school at all times.
- During PTMs or on any other occasions when children are called to school they have to come in uniform unless told.
- Uniform needs to be well maintained and clean.
- Boys' hair should be trimmed short.
- Nails to be clean and cut at all times.
- All girls to wear Hairband. Girls with short hair can tie 2 ponytails with red/black rubber bands. Girls with Long hair to wear plaits with red/black rubber bands.
- NO nail polish/ mehendi/ tattoo rings/ watches will be allowed.
- Any fancy items bought to school will be confiscated.

### **Attendance:**

- 75% attendance in school is mandatory in class.
- For leaves more than 2 days prior approval should be taken from the Principal.
- In case of any absenteeism, parents are to fill in the leave record.
- In case of medical leave, a medical certificate is to be submitted.
- Absence from school for merely social functions are strongly discouraged.


