There are going to be 4 rounds for the election process. All students will be given a chance to appear in Round 1. Kindly note the details of all the rounds.



Note - All these activities will be done under the supervision of teacher incharges.

7		Thursday, 30th April 2026	Result	Final Result will be declared and Student Council will be formed.
